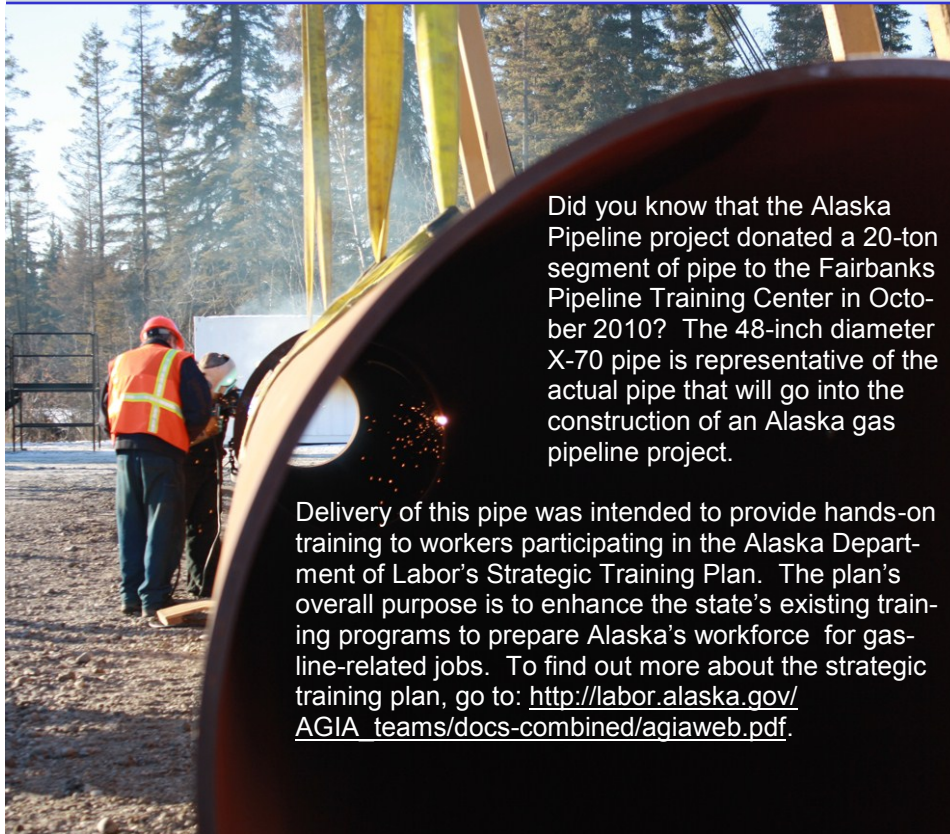

Did you know that the Alaska Pipeline project donated a 20-ton segment of pipe to the Fairbanks Pipeline Training Center in October 2010? The 48-inch diameter X-70 pipe is representative of the actual pipe that will go into the construction of an Alaska gas pipeline project.

Delivery of this pipe was intended to provide hands-on training to workers participating in the Alaska Department of Labor's Strategic Training Plan. The plan's overall purpose is to enhance the state's existing training programs to prepare Alaska's workforce for gas-line-related jobs.
