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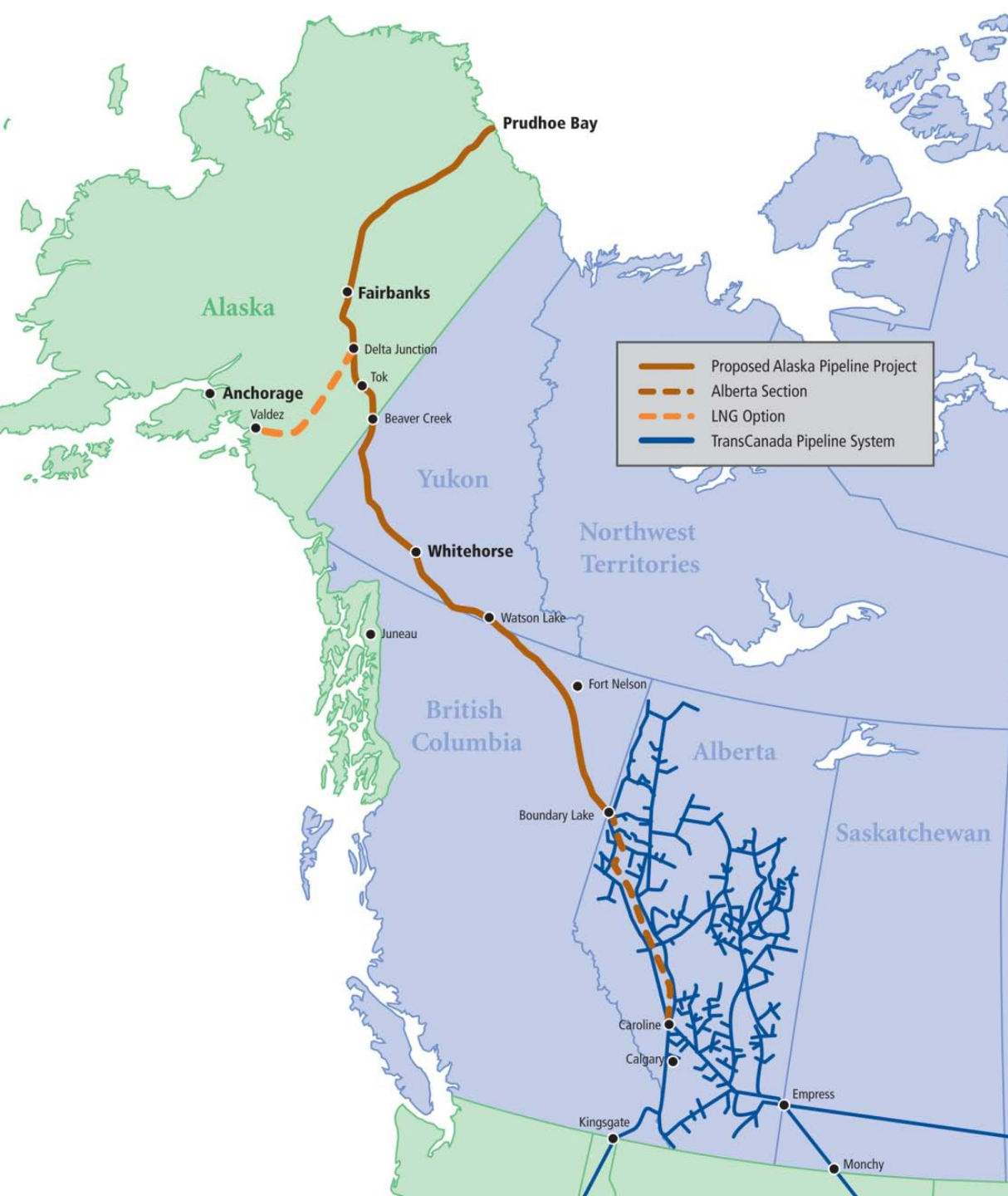
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- The AGIA Pipeline will be the largest infrastructure project in North America
- Gas Treatment Plant in Prudhoe Bay
- Pipeline from Prudhoe Bay to Alberta Hub

What Does This Mean?

- 1,700 miles of pipeline
- 48" diameter
- X80 grade
- Capacity: 4.5-5.9 bcf/day
- 2.2 million tons of pipe
- Cost: \$30-\$40 billion
- Gas Treatment Plant cost alone: \$4 billion
